## Topic: Threatened Animals of India

India is one of the 17 megadiverse countries in the World. Occupying just 2.4% of the world's land area, the country accounts for nearly 6.56 % of global faunal wealth. About 99,173 species of animals have been documented from India, till date. For reasons like habitat loss and impacts of invasive alien species, climate change and illegal trade of wild animals, the number of animal species in the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species is on the rise. More than 600 species of animals from India are currently threatened (the term threatened includes 3 categories- the Critically Endangered, Endangered and Vulnerable). Biodiversity conservation is crucial and vital not only for the protection of the environment and ecosystems, but also for social progress and economic growth of the nation. As a part of creating awareness among youngsters on conserving our faunal wealth, The ENVIS Centre, Zoological Survey of India, Kolkata is organising a National level Online PPT Competition, during the National Wildlife Week from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> October, for researchers, on the topic – 'The Threatened Animals of India'.

Communication to shortlisted participants: **By 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2021**

Presentation date (for shortlisted participants only): **5<sup>th</sup> October, 2021**

**Guidelines:**

The competition is open to researchers – JRFs and SRFs only. RAs and Post Docs need not apply.

The PPT is to be submitted from a valid email-id of the applicant, to [enviszsievents@gmail.com](mailto:enviszsievents@gmail.com)

The presentation should be in English.

The PPT is to be prepared in MS-PowerPoint 16:9 format and size not exceeding 8 MB.

A scanned photograph of the current ID card or a letter from research supervisor and one passport-size photo of the participant should be pasted on the 1<sup>st</sup> slide of the PPT.

Maximum 5 slides (excluding the ID proof slide) are allowed in the presentation.

Each participant will be given 5 min for presenting.

Content of the presentation should be original. Copied documents/pics from other sources can only be used with proper copyright. Plagiarized content will be rejected.

The PPT should be simple: avoid sound effects and animations.
