In supersession of this Ministry's OM of even number dated 27.09.2018 on the subject mentioned above it has been decided to re-constitute the Research Advisory and Monitoring Committee (RAMC) for Zoological Survey of India.

The RAMC of ZSI is hereby re-constituted with following composition:

3. The terms of reference of the RAMC will be as follows:-

Survey and Research

(a) Identify thrust areas and recommends research priority for ZSI (Survey, inventorying and documentation ot faunal species including digitization, museums, mobile application etc.).

(b) Suggest for priority research on North Eastern Fauna and Lesser known ecosystem.

(c) Formulation of the Research and Development Programme [DNA profiling, EIA and other impact studies, Eco-Sensitive Zone (ESZ) and Biosphere Reserve (BR)], Annual Review of research programmes of ZSI including externally funded projects.

#### **Database and Digitization**

(a) Review the status of publications of National, State & District, Protected Areas and Ecosystem based faunal documentation and suggest improvement.

(b) Suggest modalities for circulation of publications for the benefit of State

Government, Wildlife and Forest Departments.

(c) Review the status of database and digitization of specimens of ZSI.

(d) Recommend and suggest measures for strengthening of database of GIS mapping of faunal diversity of the country.

#### Conservation and Management

(a) Formulate research programme covering taxonomic and bio-ecological studies including priority for endangeied and threatened fauna and conservation of endangered and vulnerable species (in coordination with concerned State Forest Department).

(b) Review the list of endangered and threatened species and suggest for undertaking

programme on status survey on conservation priority.

(c) Review the status of publication on endangered species and parity with the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, IUCN, CITES and other international conservation organization.

#### Capacity Building

(a) To suggest on Consultancy and Training (CITES, Border Police, ISTM Training, Domestic and Foreign Training for scientists.

(b) Identify needs and draw-up annual capacity building and monitor the progress and suggestions for improvement.

# Review on status and maintenance of National Zoological Collections

(a) Periodic review of status of National Zoological Collections and suggestions for better maintenance of National Zoological Collections of ZSI.

#### **Emeritus Scientist Scheme**

(a) Recommend awarding of Emeritus Scientists as per laid down guidelines of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India.

### Interface between ZSI and Managers for utilization of ZSI findings

- (a) Suggest partnership with other Research Institutions working in similar field.
- (b) Recommend and suggest ways for interface between ZSI and managers for conservation and utilization of faunal resources based on the findings of ZSI.
- 4. Tenure of RAMC: The term of RAMC will be three years from the date of constitution.
- 5. The RAMC will meet twice in a year at MoEFCC-New Delhi, ZSI (HQ)-Kolkata or any of the Regional Centres of the ZSI to formulate, review and finalise the research programme action plan based on the ToR.
- 6. The committee shall be free to co-opt or otherwise associate other experts/scholars/ officials as and when deemed necessary.
- 7. The committee shall evolve its own procedure of evaluation of research activities, manpower and infrastructural development within the ToR of RAMC of ZSI.
- 8. The Non-Official Members of the Committee will be entitled for TA/DA for attending the meeting of the committee as per rules of the Government of India and will be arranged by ZSI. However, TA/DA of the official members of the committee will be met by the respective agencies/organizations/offices.
