Target Participants: College/University students, Frontline workers of agro-forestry division

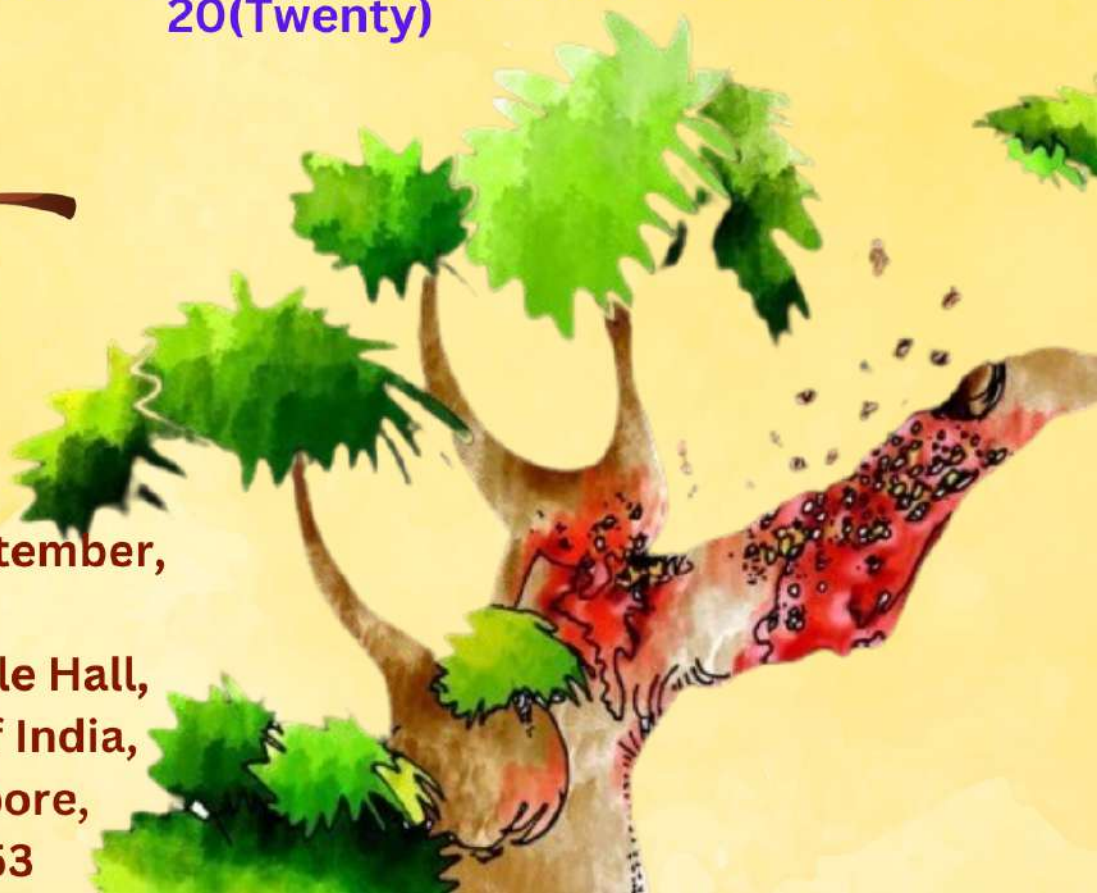
