

Many bird species are also known for their stunning plumage and songs, which they use for courtship and communication. Birds play an essential role in many ecosystems, such as pollinating flowers, dispersing seeds, and controlling insect populations. Studying birds can also provide insights into evolution, behaviour, and conservation efforts.

Global diversity: The global avian population comprises of 11,188 species that are grouped into 36 orders and 247 families.

Diversity in India: India is represented by 1358 species of birds under 26 orders and 114 families.

Endemism

Among the bird species present in India, there are 79 that are endemic, meaning they are found nowhere else in the world. The Western Ghats Bio-geographic zone has the highest number of these species at 28, with the Andaman and Nicobar Islands being the next most important area for endemism.

Habitat

They have physical and behavioural adaptations that enable them to survive in their specific environment. Some birds migrate to breed, feed, or avoid harsh weather conditions while others are resident year-round. Their adaptations include specialized beaks, feet, and camouflage to suit their habitats.

Ecological Significance

Birds have important ecological significance as pollinators, seed dispersers, predators, prey, and providers of ecosystem services such as pest control, nutrient cycling, and scavenging. They also serve as indicators of environmental health and are a source of inspiration and enjoyment for people worldwide. As a result, birds have a significant impact on the planet's ecological and cultural diversity.

According to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES), 25 species are listed under Appendix I, which includes species threatened with extinction and that are or may be affected by trade, while 141 species are listed under Appendix II, which includes species that may become threatened with extinction unless trade is regulated. The listing of species under these appendices reflects the global concern for the conservation of biodiversity and the need for international cooperation in managing trade in wild animals and plants. CITES aims to ensure that international trade in wild species does not threaten their survival, while also allowing sustainable use for the benefit of local communities and the global environment.
