I am pleased to state that ZSI is organizing the Animal Taxonomy Summit 2023 from 1st to 3rd July 2023 and the portal www.zsi.org.in is available for larger benefit of taxonomists across the globe. The capacity building workshop on implementation of CITES has been hosted by ZSI for regulating animal and plant trade in India in which senior forest officials from State Governments were participated. Various awareness programmes on Mission LiFE have been organized by ZSI Headquarters and Regional Centres on themes, save water, save energy, go green, adopt millets etc. ZSI received the Special Recognition Award at Pride of India Expo, an exhibition themed on the importance of animals and their role in the Ecosystem held in Pune during the Indian Science Congress. Faunistic surveys conducted to Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Bihar, West Bengal, Himachal Pradesh and Golden Quadrilateral Highway covering different states to assess the faunal diversity. Altogether 14275 specimens comprising 1528 species including 13 new species and 11 new records to India were identified. As a part of molecular studies, 146 DNA barcodes have been generated and uploaded in BOLD. The facilities of ZSI at headquarters and Regional Centres were visited by 21760 persons in including researchers, students and general public at large. 74th Republic Day of the country was celebrated befittingly at all the ZSI offices across the country by unfurling the National Flag.

A web portal on Animal Taxonomy Summit 2023 to be organized by ZSI from 1st – 3rd July 2023 has been launched by Dr. Dhriti Banerjee, Director, ZSI on the occasion of 74th Republic Day celebration at ZSI Headquarters. A month long orientation programme on Beyond Taxonomy has been organized for the newly recruited Senior Zoological Assistants by delivering several lectures on the different thematic areas. ZSI hosted the Capacity Building Workshop on Implementation of Provisions of CITES organized by MoEFCC on 20th January 2023 at Kolkata for formulating a road map with delegates for forthcoming CITES Conference of Parties meeting for the benefit of senior officials of State Forest Departments as well as scientific authorities of CITES in India. Another capacity building workshop for 40 frontline staff of West Bengal Forest Department for identification of scheduled animals has been organized by ZSI from 16th to 17th January 2023. Altogether 7319 specimens comprising 1715 species under different faunal groups have been identified. Among them one species each under Orthoptera and Collumbola were turned out as new to science while 42 species were augmented first time to the National Zoological Collections. Provided the comments to Statistics Division, MoEFCC on National State of Environment Report 2020-21: Biodiversity and Wildlife prepared for MoEFCC by TERI. Replies for Rajya Sabha Q.Dy.No. S 538 regarding "Extinct Wildlife Species in Rajasthan" due for reply on 02.02.2023 and Rajya Sabha Starred/unstarred Question Dy.No.

U1390 regarding 'Bird Census' due for answer on 09.02.2023 were submitted to the Ministry. Surveys were conducted in Middle Andaman, the Golden Quadrilateral Highway and Wild life Sanctuaries of West Bengal during the month. As mandated by DoPT, Career progression training for Senior Zoological Assistants are underway at ZSI headquarters in which the eligible scientific staff from ZSI headquarters as well as Regional Centres are getting benefitted. Dr. Souvik Sen, Scientist-D received the 'Best Participant Award' in a National online workshop on 'Ecological Paradigms - an Applied Perspective (Phase I- Ecosystem)' organized by the Zoological Society, Kolkata.



North Eastern Regional Centre, Shillong, Meghalaya

Total 57 species were identified belonging to Hemiptera, Amphibia, Pisces, Mammals and Reptiles. Under the Mission LiFE, a water conservation awareness activity was organized on 23rd January 2023 at Lamlyer, Mawrynkneng, East Khasi Hills and a rally was organized to create awareness on ban on plastic of less than 120 micron on 25th January 2023. Republic Day was celebrated on 26th January, 2023. Advisory service rendered to Don Bosco University regarding some distribution information and pattern vis-à-vis potential impacts of climate change on anuran amphibians of Khasi Hills region. One fish species (*Bangana dero*) was identified for North Eastern Hill University, Shillong.

Three surveys have been conducted during the month to Bhagwan Mahaveer Sanctuary and Mollem National Park, Goa from 16th to 24th January, 2023, Jogimatti Wildlife Sanctuary and Uttaregudda Wildlife Sanctuary, Karnataka from 15th to 21st January 2023. Altogether 72 species belonging to Decapoda, Coleoptera and Lepidoptera was identified. Identification and advisory services provided to Probationary Police Sub Inspector, Maharashtra on tanned skin and antlers, to the Range Forest Officer, Maharashtra, on tanned skin, to Shri Rohit Mohite, Maharashtra on python and to Range Forest Officer, Maharashtra on Reptilia and also to Thiru Kolanjiappar Government Arts College, Tamil Nadu on freshwater crabs. Nine sequences (mt 16S rRNA) of reptilian samples from the Western Ghats have been submitted. A book entitled, Corona kalath oru Vavval (Bats of Kerala in Malayalam) authored by Dr M.J. Palot, Scientist-B has been awarded by the Kerala Council for Science, Technology, and Environment (KCSTE), Government of Kerala under the category of best science book for children. Participated and show cased the faunal diversity and publications to the visitors at the "Shining Maharashtra" exhibition held at Akluj, Solapur district, Maharashtra from 22nd to 24th December 2022. 

D. Thesis received from Deemed University, FRI, Dehradun.

Southern Regional Centre, Chennai, Tamil Nadu

The scientists of this Centre discovered five species of genus *Thraulus* (Ephemeroptera: Leptophlebiidae) viz., *Thraulus amravati* Vasanth, Subramanian & Selvakumar, 2022, *Thraulus cuspidatus* Vasanth, Subramanian & Selvakumar, 2022, *Thraulus malabarensis* Vasanth, Subramanian & Selvakumar, 2022, *Thraulus plumeus* Selvakumar, Vasanth & Subramanian, 2022 and *Thraulus vellimalaiensis* Vasanth, Subramanian & Selvakumar, 2022 from different regions of India. A total of 180 species from Ephemeroptera, Odonata, Lepidoptera, Plecoptera, Mollusca, Rotifera, Cladocera, Rhizopoda, Ostracoda, Amphibia and Reptiles were identified during the month. A field faunal survey was conducted along the proposed greenfield highway between Palakkad and Kozhikode. The scientist reviewed the manuscript for an SCI journal.

Conducted one faunistic survey to Bihar from 30.01.2023 to 09.02.2023. 45 species were identified during the month.
