- 1. Celebration of 109th foundation day of ZSI and inaugurated Animal Taxonomy Summit 2024 on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024, Sri Bhupender Yadav, Hon'ble Minister of MoEF&CC, New Delhi was the Chief Guest of the function; Ms. Namita Prasad, Joint Secretary, MoEF & CC, New Delhi chaired valedictory session of ATS 2024 on 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2024.
- 2. ZSI organised tree plantation drive under 'Ek Per Maa Ke Naam' launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024.
- 3. ZSI Scientists attended a meeting held under the chairpersonship of Ms. Nameeta Prasad, Joint Secretary, MoEF&CC on 30.05.2024 to discuss the Red Listing of species and their monitoring.
- 4. Celebrated International Yoga Day on 21st June 2024 at ZSI, HQ and RCs.
- 5. Celebrated Paryavaran Divas and World Environment Day 2024 and distributed plant saplings to the officers and staff members at ZSI, HQ and RCs.
- 6. ZSI organized Quarterly Hindi meeting, and Rajbhasha Workshop on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 at RCs.
- 7. Mission Life and *Swachchta Hi Seva* Special Campaigns 3.0 were conducted to generate awareness among people in HQ and RCs.
- 8. EIACP Centre on Biodiversity (Fauna), ZSI organized a National Webinar on 'Soil Invertebrates and Restoration Ecology' on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2024.
