

I am pleased to inform you about the successful release of the May 2024 issue of the monthly ENEWS from the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI), which highlights the most recent accomplishments, developments, and findings in the realms of research and fauna exploration. Within these electronic pages, you will be taken on a captivating voyage into the realms of science and exploration, with each piece serving as evidence of taxonomic advancement, conservation initiatives, and innovative approaches to preserve biodiversity. Our ZSI E-NEWS aims to bridge the gap between our scientific

community and the general public by providing valuable information about our ongoing research and its outcomes. With each edition, we offer a window into the dynamic and diverse field of zoology, highlighting the vital efforts undertaken by ZSI to study and protect India's abundant and distinctive wildlife.

Director, ZSI along with officials made a comprehensive discussion on Cetaceans study for the proposed Versova-Bandra Sea Link (VBSL) at VBSL Project Office in Mumbai. Director, ZSI, along with officials attended a meeting with Additional Chief Secretary, Tamil Nadu to discuss various issues related to the development of Zoological Survey of India. Director, ZSI, attended a scheduled meeting at the Natural History Museum (NHM) in London on 20th May 2024 with Dr. Tim Littlewood (Executive Director of Science), Dr. John Jackson (Head of Science Policy and Communication), Dr. Roberto Portela Miguez (Senior Curator in Charge, Mammals), Dr. Patrick Campbell (Senior Curator, Reptiles), Dr. Tom White (Senior Curator, Non-Insect Invertebrates), Dr. Ranee Om Prakash (Senior Curator-Flowering) Plants), Isabel Davis (Research Theme Leader, Collections and Culture), Ms. Helen Robertson (Head of Postgraduate Studies, NHM) and Dr. Jesus Hernandez to discuss ongoing projects, potential collaborations, and recent advancements in the field of natural history and museum curation and the potential of ZSI working with NHM on digitizing the faunal collection in ZSI and in NHM in order to bring out the complete virtual fauna of India. ZSI provided the inputs on the Ministry for Ocean and Climate Change Dialogue 2024 related to two topics of the dialogue scheduled to be held from 11–12 June 2024 in conjunction with the Subsidiary Body session to be held in Bonn, Germany from 3-13 June 2024. In this month, ZSI researchers have successfully identified a total of 1514 species of faunal communities. encompassing 12 new species with one species of Eel, one species of Pseudoscorpion, two species of hemiptera and eight species of lepidoptera. Notably, seven Lepidoptera species have been newly recorded as distributed in India. Additionally, a sum of 52 DNA Barcodes has been generated throughout this month.

I would like to express my sincere appreciation to all those who contributed to the success of this publication and research accomplishments. I also extend special thanks to our readers for your unwavering support and interest in our endeavors. Your involvement inspires us to strive for excellence and innovation in fulfilling our mission. As we move forward, we remain dedicated to advancing our scientific knowledge and fostering a deeper reverence for the natural world. I urge every one of you to continue sharing your feedback and ideas, as they are crucial in shaping the future of our ENEWS and ensuring its significance and impact.

HEADQUARTERS, KOLKATA

A total of 743 species of faunal communities belonging to Arachnida, Apterygota, Chalcididae, Diptera, Formicidae, Hemiptera, Orthoptera, Lepidoptera, Mollusca, Acanthocephala, Nematoda, Platyhelminthes, Porifera, Cnidaria, Annelida and Echinodermata were identified during the month. 8 species of Lepidoptera and 2 species of Hemiptera were described as New to Science and 1 species of Mollusca and 7 species of Lepidoptera were recorded as new to Indian fauna during the month. 2 species of Hemiptera, 38 species of Lepidoptera, 5 species of Nematode, and 3 species of Platyhelminthes were augmented to National Zoological Collections. Identification & Advisory services were rendered

to Gulf of Mannar Biosphere Reserve Centre for Marine Biodiversity, Department of Aquatic Biology and Fisheries, Manipur University, Department of Zoology, University of Calcutta, Department of Zoology, Diamond Harbour Women's University and Department of Biomedical Engineering, Netaji Subhas Engineering College, Bhavnagar University, Gujarat, Aligarh Muslim University, Laxmi Organics, Chhattisgarh and KVK Kargil-1 (SKUAST). Training on the Taxonomy of Collembola was imparted to PG students of CSJMU, Kanpur, and on Collection, preservation, and identification of Platyhelminthes parasites to PG students of Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj University, Kanpur.

NORTH EASTERN REGIONAL CENTRE, SHILLONG, MEGHALAYA

A total of 57 species of faunal communities belonging to Orthoptera, Odonata, Araneae, Hemiptera, Lepidoptera, Crustacea Mollusca, Pisces, Reptilia, and Amphibia were identified. Identification and advisory services were rendered to the Wildlife Trust of India and Royal Bhutan University. A MoU was signed between the ZSI and the Natural History Museum of Geneva for collaboration on mammalian taxonomic research. International Day for Biological Diversity was celebrated on 22nd May 2024 with the students of St. Peter's School, Shillong. A plantation drive was conducted on the campus of the North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homeopathy, Shillong, Meghalaya. Visitors from Osmania University, Guwahati College, and Pragjyotish College visited the centre during the month.

SOUTHERN REGIONAL CENTRE, CHENNAI, TAMIL NADU

A total of 204 species of faunal communities belonging to Ephemeroptera, Hemiptera, Lepidoptera, Odonata, Psocoptera, Mollusca, Fishes, Amphibia, Aves, Reptilia, and Zooplankton were identified. This centre conducted an awareness and internship programme for postgraduate students of Zoology from various colleges under Madras University, Chennai, from May 16th to 31st May 2024. One new genus and species of fossil Psuedoscorpion (Geogarypidae: Geogaranya valiyaensis) was recorded as new to science. ESTUARINE BIOLOGY REGIONAL CENTRE, GOPALPUR-ON-SEA, ODISHA


Local surveys of Bahuda estuary and Gopalpur coast. A total of 150 species of different faunal groups were identified. *Ariosoma thoothukudiense* Kodeeswaran, Kathirvelpandian, Mohapatra, and Kumar, 2024 is described from the Tamil Nadu coast in collaboration with NBFGR- ICAR. Two DNA barcodes belonging to one species were uploaded to the NCBI data base. A large hammer-headed shark, *Sphyrna lewini* (Griffith & Smith, 1834) of 104 kg was recorded in the catch at Gopalpur.




